1. Wasteland – WSL – Land of extremely poor quality due to erosion or soil type that is severely restricted in its ability to support domestic livestock. Must be an integral part of one or more of the land types listed below. ACRES _____
2. Native pasture very poor – NPVP – Heavy brush and trees that restrict the domestic livestock carrying capacity of the land (very rough soil mostly rocks) ACRES _____
3. Native pasture poor – NPP – Heavy brush and trees that restrict the domestic livestock carrying capacity of the land (rough soil heavy with rocks) ACRES _____
4. Native pasture fair – NPF – Partially cleared of brush and trees with a mixture of native and/or tame grasses used for grazing of domestic livestock (average soil with some rocks) ACRES _____
5. Native pasture good – NPG – Mostly cleared of brush and trees with a mixture of native and/or tame grasses used for grazing of domestic livestock (rich soil with little to no rocks) ACRES _____
6. Improved pasture fair – IPF – Perennial grasses (Bluestem, Kline, Bermuda etc.) that are baled and/or grazed by domestic livestock (average soil with some rocks) ACRES _____
7. Improves pasture good – IPG - Perennial grasses (Bluestem, Kline, Bermuda etc.) that are baled and/or grazed by domestic livestock (rich soil with little to no rocks) ACRES _____
8. Dry cropland fair – DCF – Land planted in row or broadcast crops that are grown for sale or used for feed in your livestock operation (average soil with some rocks) ACRES _____
9. Dry cropland good – DCG - Land planted in row or broadcast crops that are grown for sale or used for feed in your livestock operation (rich soil with little to no rocks) ACRES _____
10. Irrigated cropland fair – ICF – Cultivated and planted to annual crops that are watered on a regular basis (average soil with some rocks) includes truck farming ACRES _____
11. Irrigated cropland good – ICG - Cultivated and planted to annual crops that are watered on a regular basis (rich soil with little to no rocks) includes truck farming ACRES _____
12. Orchards/nursery – OR – Land having trees planted for the specific purpose of producing fruit and/or nut crops and nursery stock ACRES _____
